[Blood: Is the Life](#)

Genesis 9:4 (NKJV) “But you shall not eat flesh with its life, [that is,] its blood.”

Leviticus 17:11 (NKJV) ‘For the life of the flesh [is] in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it [is] the blood [that] makes atonement for the soul.’

Leviticus 17:14 (NKJV) “for [it is] the life of all flesh. Its blood sustains its life. Therefore I said to the children of Israel, ‘You shall not eat the blood of any flesh, for the life of all flesh is its blood. Whoever eats it shall be cut off.’”

Deuteronomy 12:23 (NKJV) “Only be sure that you do not eat the blood, for the blood [is] the life; you may not eat the life with the meat.”

Genesis 9:4 (NKJV) “But you shall not eat flesh with its life, [that is,] its blood.”

Leviticus 3:17 (NKJV) ‘[This shall be] a perpetual statute throughout your generations in all your dwellings: you shall eat neither fat nor blood.’”

Leviticus 7:26 (NKJV) ‘Moreover you shall not eat any blood in any of your dwellings, [whether] of bird or beast.’”

Leviticus 7:27 (NKJV) ‘Whoever eats any blood, that person shall be cut off from his people.’”

Ezekiel 33:25 (NKJV) “Therefore say to them, ‘Thus says the Lord GOD: “You eat [meat] with blood, you lift

up your eyes toward your idols, and shed blood. Should you then possess the land?”

Acts 15:20 (NKJV) “but that we write to them to abstain from things polluted by idols, [from] sexual immorality, [from] things strangled, and [from] blood.”

Acts 15:29 (NKJV) that you abstain from things offered to idols, from blood, from things strangled, and from sexual immorality. If you keep yourselves from these, you will do well. Farewell.”

Acts 21:25 (NKJV) “But concerning the Gentiles who believe, we have written [and] decided that they should observe no such thing, except that they should keep themselves from [things] offered to idols, from blood, from things strangled, and from sexual immorality.”

Exodus 7:17-25 (NKJV)

Blood: Sacrificial

Without shedding of, no remission,

Hebrews 9:22 (NKJV)

“And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.”

Sprinkled on altar and people.

Exodus 24:6-8 (NKJV)

And Moses took half the blood and put [it] in basins, and half the blood he sprinkled on the altar. 7 Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read in the hearing of the people. And they said, “All that the LORD has said we will do, and be obedient.” 8 And Moses took the

blood, sprinkled [it] on the people, and said, “This is the blood of the covenant which the LORD has made with you according to all these words.”

Ezekiel 43:20 (NKJV)

‘You shall take some of its blood and put [it] on the four horns of the altar, on the four corners of the ledge, and on the rim around it; thus you shall cleanse it and make atonement for it.’

Sprinkled on door posts.

Exodus 12:7-23 (NKJV)

V. 23 “For the LORD will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the LORD will pass over the door and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike [you.]”

Hebrews 11:28 (NKJV)

“By faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood, lest he who destroyed the firstborn should touch them.”

OF SIN OFFERING:

Sprinkled seven times before the veil,

Leviticus 4:5,6,17 (NKJV)

‘Then the anointed priest shall take some of the bull’s blood and bring it to the tabernacle of meeting. 6. The priest shall dip his finger in the blood and sprinkle some of the blood seven times before the LORD, in front of the veil of the sanctuary. 17. Then the priest shall dip his

finger in the blood and sprinkle *it* seven times before the LORD, in front of the veil.”

on the horns of the altar of sweet incense, and at the bottom of the altar of burnt offering,

Exodus 30:10 (NKJV)

“And Aaron shall make atonement upon its horns once a year with the blood of the sin offering of atonement; once a year he shall make atonement upon it throughout your generations. It [is] most holy to the LORD.”

Leviticus 4:7 (NKJV)

‘And the priest shall put some of the blood on the horns of the altar of sweet incense before the LORD, which is in the tabernacle of meeting; and he shall pour the remaining blood of the bull at the base of the altar of the burnt offering, which is at the door of the tabernacle of meeting.’

Of the bullock of sin offering, put on the horns of the altar,

Leviticus 8:15 (NKJV)

“and Moses killed [it.] Then he took the blood, and put [some] on the horns of the altar all around with his finger, and purified the altar. And he poured the blood at the base of the altar, and consecrated it, to make atonement for it.”

poured at the bottom of the altar,

Exodus 29:12 (NKJV)

“You shall take [some] of the blood of the bull and put [it] on the horns of the altar with your finger, and pour all the blood beside the base of the altar.

OF TRESPASS OFFERING:

Sprinkled on the altar,

Leviticus 7:2 (NKJV)

“In the place where they kill the burnt offering they shall kill the trespass offering. And its blood he shall sprinkle all around on the altar.”

OF BURNT OFFERING:

Sprinkled all around, and upon the altar,

Exodus 29:16 (NKJV)

“and you shall kill the ram, and you shall take its blood and sprinkle [it] all around on the altar.”

Deuteronomy 12:27 (NKJV)

“And you shall offer your burnt offerings, the meat and the blood, on the altar of the LORD your God; and the blood of your sacrifices shall be poured out on the altar of the LORD your God, and you shall eat the meat.

Used for cleansing of leprosy,

Leviticus 14:6-7 (NKJV)

“As for the living bird, he shall take it, the cedar wood and the scarlet and the hyssop, and dip them and the living bird in the blood of the bird [that was] killed over the running water. And he shall sprinkle it seven times on him who is to be cleansed from the leprosy, and shall

pronounce him clean, and shall let the living bird loose in the open field.“

OF PEACE OFFERING:

Sprinkled about the altar,

Leviticus 3:2 (NKJV)

‘And he shall lay his hand on the head of his offering, and kill it [at] the door of the tabernacle of meeting; and Aaron’s sons, the priests, shall sprinkle the blood all around on the altar.’”

Leviticus 9:18 (NKJV)

“He also killed the bull and the ram [as] sacrifices of peace offerings, which [were] for the people. And Aaron’s sons presented to him the blood, which he sprinkled all around on the altar,”

Blood of the ram of consecration put on the tip of right ear, thumb, and big toe of, and sprinkled upon, Aaron and his sons,

Exodus 29:21 (NKJV)

“And you shall take some of the blood that is on the altar, and some of the anointing oil, and sprinkle [it] on Aaron and on his garments, on his sons and on the garments of his sons with him; and he and his garments shall be hallowed, and his sons and his sons’ garments with him.”

Leviticus 8:23 (NKJV)

“and Moses killed [it.] Also he took [some] of its blood and put it on the tip of Aaron’s right ear, on the thumb of his right hand, and on the big toe of his right foot.”

- **As priests, they should HEAR differently, they should WORK differently and they should WALK differently.**

The right side was considered superior, with more strength and skill. God wanted their best to be dedicated to Him.

OF ATONEMENT:

Sprinkled on the mercy seat,

Leviticus 16:14-15 (NKJV)

“He shall take some of the blood of the bull and sprinkle [it] with his finger on the mercy seat on the east [side;] and before the mercy seat he shall sprinkle some of the blood with his finger seven times. Then he shall kill the goat of the sin offering, which *is* for the people, bring its blood inside the veil, do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bull, and sprinkle it on the mercy seat and before the mercy seat.”

BLOOD OF THE COVENANT:

Exodus 24:5-8 (NKJV)

“Then he sent young men of the children of Israel, who offered burnt offerings and sacrificed peace offerings of oxen to the LORD. 6 And Moses took half the blood and put [it] in basins, and half the blood he sprinkled on the altar. 7 Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read

in the hearing of the people. And they said, “All that the LORD has said we will do, and be obedient.” 8 And Moses took the blood, sprinkled [it] on the people, and said, “This is the blood of the covenant which the LORD has made with you according to all these words.”

Psalms 32:1-2,

”Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man unto whom The Lord does not impute iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile.”

Zechariah 9:11 (NKJV)

“As for you also, Because of the blood of your covenant, I will set your prisoners free from the waterless pit.”

Matthew 26:28 (NKJV)

“For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.”

Hebrews 9:18 (NKJV)

“Therefore not even the first [covenant] was dedicated without blood.”

Hebrews 9:19 (NKJV)

“For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and goats, with water, scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book itself and all the people,”

Hebrews 9:22 (NKJV)

“And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.”

NB. The blood of bulls and goats only covered sin. It could not remove sin!

Hebrews 10:29 (NKJV)

“Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?”

Hebrews 13:20-21 (NKJV)

“Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to Whom be glory forever and ever. Amen “

Revelation 16:6 (NKJV)

“For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets,
And You have given them blood to drink. For it is their just due.”

Blood: Of Sacrifices, Typical of the Atoning Blood of Christ

Hebrews 9:6-28 (NKJV)

Blood: Of Christ

Matthew 26:28 (NKJV)

“For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.”

John 6:53-56 (NKJV)

“Then Jesus said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. 54 “Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. 55 “For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. 56 “He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him.”

John 19:34 (NKJV)

“But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out.”

Acts 20:28 (NKJV)

“Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.”

Romans 3:24-25 (NKJV)

“being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God set forth [as] a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed,”

Romans 5:9 (NKJV)

“Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.”

1 Corinthians 10:16 (NKJV)

“The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?”

1 Corinthians 11:25 (NKJV)

“In the same manner [He] also [took] the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink [it,] in remembrance of Me.”

Ephesians 1:7 (NKJV)

“In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.”

Ephesians 2:13 (NKJV)

“But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.”

Ephesians 2:16 (NKJV)

“and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.”

Colossians 1:14 (NKJV)

“in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.”

Colossians 1:20 (NKJV)

“and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.”

Hebrews 9:12-14 (NKJV)

“Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. 13 For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, 14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?”

Hebrews 10:19 (NKJV)

“Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh,”

Hebrews 10:29 (NKJV)

“Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?”

Hebrews 12:24 (NKJV)

“to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than [that of] Abel.”

Hebrews 13:12 (NKJV)

“Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate.”

1 Peter 1:2 (NKJV)

“elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace be multiplied.”

1 Peter 1:18 (NKJV)

“knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, [like] silver or gold, from your aimless conduct [received] by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.”

1 John 1:7 (NKJV)

“But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.”

1 John 5:6 (NKJV)

“This is He who came by water and blood--Jesus Christ; not only by water, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit who bears witness, because the Spirit is truth.”

1 John 5:8 (NKJV)

“And there are three that bear witness on earth: the Spirit, the water, and the blood; and these three agree as one.”

Revelation 1:5-6 (NKJV)

“and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth.

To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him *be* glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.“

Revelation 5:9 (NKJV)

“And they sang a new song, saying: “You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,”

Revelation 7:14 (NKJV)

“And I said to him, “Sir, you know.” So he said to me, “These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.“

Revelation 12:11 (NKJV)

“And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.”

Summary:

- The blood of Jesus speaks on earth and in heaven. Jesus our mediator - our Advocate - Our Great High Priest. The One Who intervenes between two, in order to make or restore peace and friendship.
- It speaks of better things than the blood of Abel.
- It pleads for mercy instead of vengeance.
- It speaks PARDON to our sins, and PEACE to our souls.

- Abel's blood spoke from the ground, but God spoke by angels, by Moses, through the prophets on earth, now He speaks from heaven, His Final Word Through His Son Jesus (Hebrews 1).
- He speaks today, through The Gospel - The GRACE of God. Free gift of salvation.

What does the blood say?

1. We are justified - in right standing with God (Romans 3:24-25; Romans 5:9). Declared "not guilty"!
2. We are protected (Exodus 12:7-23) "When I see the blood..."
3. We are reconciled to God - (Ephesians 2:16)
4. We have been purchased (Acts 20:28)
5. We have been redeemed (Revelation 5:9; Romans 3:24-25; Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14; 1 Peter 1:18).
6. We are under a New Covenant built on better promises (1 Corinthians 11:25).
7. We are not under Law but under Grace - (Ephesians 2:8-9).
8. We have forgiveness of sins -(Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14)
9. We have been brought near to God - (Ephesians 2:13).
10. We have peace with God - (Colossians 1:20)
11. It cleanses our conscience from dead works - (Hebrews 9:12-14).

12. It gives us boldness and confidence to enter The Holiest Place - (Hebrews 10:19).
13. We are sanctified - (Hebrews 13:12).
14. We are cleansed & washed from all sin - (1 John 1:7; Revelation 1:5-6; Revelation 7:14 - Washed and made white! Pure! Holy!
15. The blood bears witness here on earth - (1 John 5:6-8).
16. We can overcome the devil by The Blood of The Lamb and by The WORD of our testimony - (Revelation 12:11)

Conclusion:

- The blood of Christ is a powerful weapon against the thief who has come to steal, kill and destroy.
 - Declare daily the victory of the blood.
 - Apply the blood over your life, your family, your possessions, your calling, your church, your city, your nation. We plead The Blood!
 - We remind Satan of what the blood has accomplished.
 - We use it as a shield against the fiery darts of the evil one.
 - Old Pentecostal Song: “There is power, power, wonder working power in the blood of The Lamb....”!
- Lord, demonstrate the power of Your Blood in my life and through my life! Amen
